

## Pulo Gelang (Geylang Island)



There are mentions of Gaylang village and Pulo Gelang (Geylang Island) in an 1849 map, both of which disappeared when the Kallang Basin underwent reclamation. The ancient map also details the presence of a large coconut plantation that serves as the inspiration for this drink, using a coconut and butter wash to create an aromatic and velvety spirit-forward drink.

*Coconut washed Mount Gay Eclipse Rum, Bacardi 8 years, Velvet Falernum, Cacao Bitter, Roasted Coconut*


## Huay Sia



Kallang Gasworks was built in 1862 by the Singapore Gas Company to supply piped gas for street lighting. The company originally had four tanks: The first two were built in 1862 and demolished in 1957; the third and fourth were both added in the early 20th century. Many locals would avoid the Kallang area due to the stench of gas as well as fears of an exploding pipeline, hence the complex was given its nickname huay sia, or “fire city” in Hokkien. The fiery danger that Kallang Gasworks posed to the neighbourhood serves as this drink’s inspiration.

*Balvenie 12, Cacao-infused Sweet Vermouth, Demarara, Coffee and Cacao Bitters. Smoked with Cherry wood*

## Serai Serai



As its name suggests, this drink is inspired by Geylang Serai, one of the oldest Malay settlements in Singapore, “Serai” meaning “lemongrass” in Malay. Lemongrass and citronella plants were cultivated for essential oils in the late 19th century in a plantation called “Perseverance Estate” located between Paya Lebar Road and Jalan Eunos, and for a time was only accessible by Geylang Road. As a result of the plantation’s success between the 1860s and 1890s, the area's close association with lemongrass and citronella had become so ingrained in public memory that the name persisted beyond the plantation’s existence.

*Lemongrass-infused Mount Gay Silver rum, Campari, Lemongrass & Citronella mix, Pandan*

## Kal ‘Lan’



Kallang Riverside can be seen recorded in the Cho Clan Archives as being the original landing site of Sir Stamford Raffles, following the route of his ship’s carpenter, Chow Ah Chi, who reportedly landed on the banks of the Rochor river first. Kallang River, Singapore's longest river, has undergone a massive transformation to become the vibrant sight that it is today. Kal 'Lan', Lan meaning “blue” in Mandarin, is inspired by the beautiful river reflecting the clear blue sky on its surface.

## Lady Rose



There is an oddly beautiful vibe around Geylang, Singapore's "Sin City". In dark corners of the neighbourhood, men would huddle over propped up tables to gamble, enshrouded in the smoke of contraband cigarettes sold mere footsteps away. Fluorescent blues and pinks from the brothels' neon signs illuminate dark alleyways, along which sex workers can be seen plying their trade while seated on plastic stools or leaning against walls. And among them in the shadows, a mysterious lady named Rose whose reputation is spoken of in whispers. For those who come in search of her, they shall realise the truth behind "No money no love".




## Classic Old Fashioned

Rum, Sugar, Lime




## Classic Martini

Blended Malt, Peated Whisky, Spiced Ginger, Honey & Lemon




## The Manhattan

Gin, Cherry Heering, Benedictine, Cointreau, Maraschino Liqueur, Grenadine, Pineapple, Lime, Angostura Bitters






